The Little Loon Regional Park is located 5 kms East of Glaslyn on Hwy #3. You will enjoy a natural Northern Saskatchewan woodland setting throughout the whole park, which features a quiet and non-commercialized atmosphere on our golf course which is one of a kind. Our park has something to offer for everyone, so come join in on the fun!

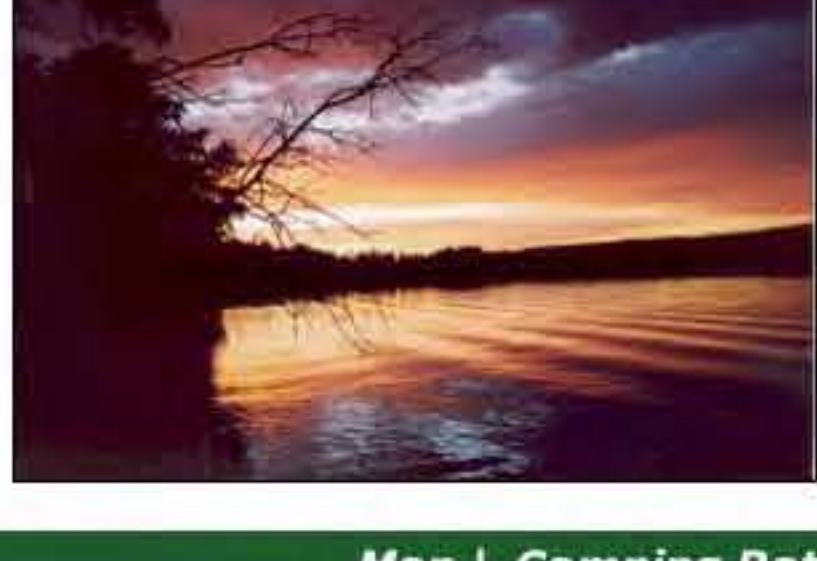


Local Services

Our concession offers home-made cooking and basic groceries. A laundromat, shower house and pay phone are also available. The Villages of Glaslyn and Medstead are only a short distance away and offer museums, hardware stores, grocery stores, mechanical, medical and worship services. The park concession provides the usual ice cream, pop, chips, bars, slushes, tea & coffee. Aside from the usual you can treat yourself to a bowl of homemade soup & sandwich or a juicy homestyle burger & fries. Dry ribs are also a big hit! As well we sell fish licenses, golf shirts and balls with the park logo on them. Sunday mornings the park board puts on a pancake & sausage breakfast on the concession deck.

Park/Area History

The Regional Park was established in the 1960s and was done so by local volunteers. Trees, stumps and sand from along the lake were hauled out to build a beach and swimming hole. The original golf course was built by breaking the brush and working it down to eventually having grass. The golf course had its grand opening in 1970. The clubhouse was created from renovating an old one-room Heritage School building.

There are 21 electric sites with water, 20 non-electric sites, our campsites each have a picnic table, pole bbq, and trash can. 12 of the non-electric sites are very well treed along the lake.



Group Camping

Our campsites are situated and large enough to accommodate 20 or more RV's in one area for large gatherings. There is also plenty of room to set up a large tent for those functions if you desire.

Swimming

Our beach is not large but is well maintained. We are in the process of beach and dock improvements. The park also plans to have kayaking and canoeing clinics. Contact the park office for dates.



Playground/Recreation Activities

We have recently installed a new playground which consists of slides, swings, teeter totters, glide ride, etc. The area is confined with a chain link fence along the roadside for your children's safety and has beautiful park benches for mom & dad's comfort!



Boating and Fishing

The park has a fine boat launch and parking lot for boat trailers. Because the lake is on a smaller scale it is very seldom the waves get too high to venture out on the water. The hot afternoon is perfect for water skiing or wake boarding. If dad has forgotten to purchase his fishing license we can fix him up with one at the club house.



Golfing

Golfing Rates

The park has one of the greatest golf courses in the area. The 9-hole, par 33 grass green course is well groomed with watered fairways and covers over 2000 yards. Golf carts and golf clubs are available for rent. For those who want to practice their putting skill you can try the 18-hole mini-golf course. We offer discounted rates for schools to bring their students out. The golf club hosts seven golf tournaments throughout the summer. Monday evenings - ladies golfing, Wednesday evenings - mens golfing.



Mini Golf

We have an 18 hole mini golf course which can be a challenge for any age! Also other activities available in the park are horseshoe pits and a sand volleyball court.



Hiking/Nature Trails

As the park is located in the country there are many beautiful side trails for biking, hiking and taking in nature's beauty.
