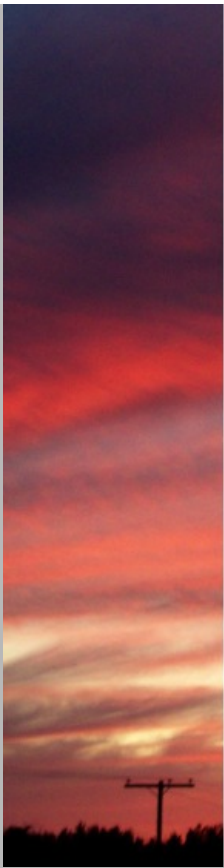
Putin says U.S. is "parasite" on global economy



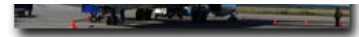
Russian Prime Minister Vladimir Putin is on the campaign trail and on Monday addressing a large gathering of young supporters he pointed out that the United States and its economic

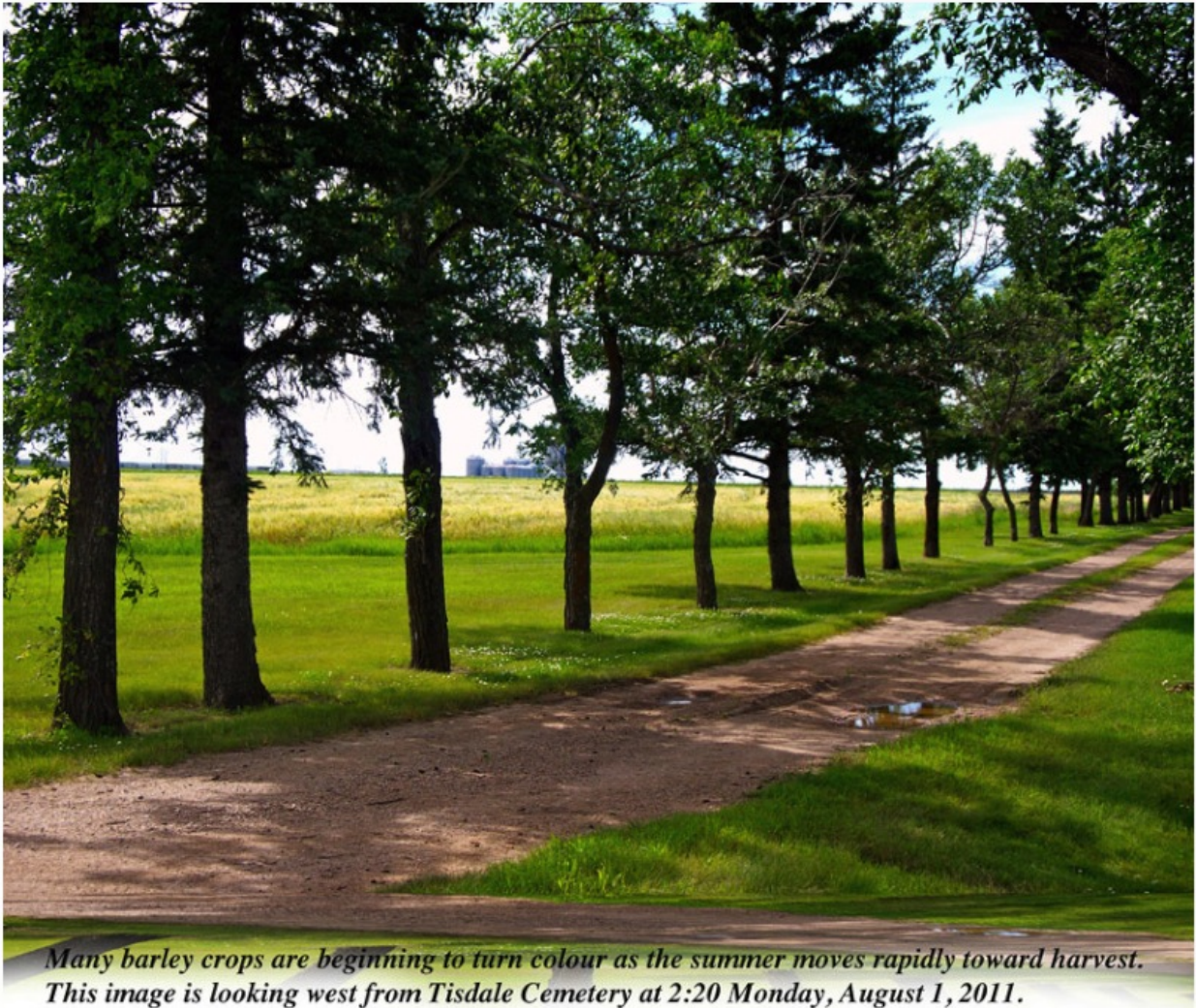
