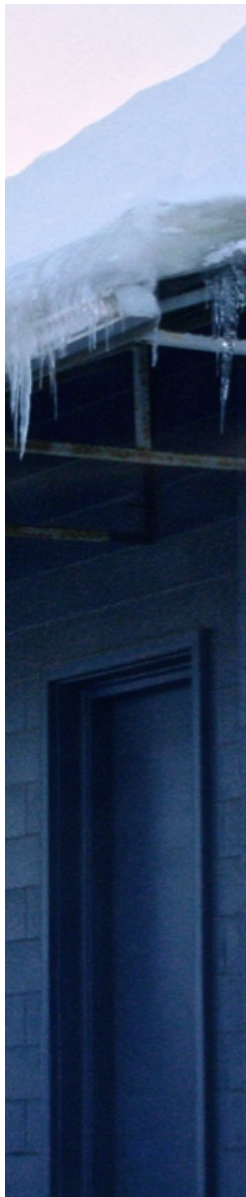
Find of the Day

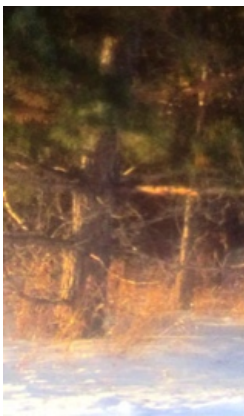
