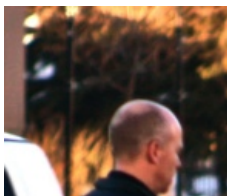
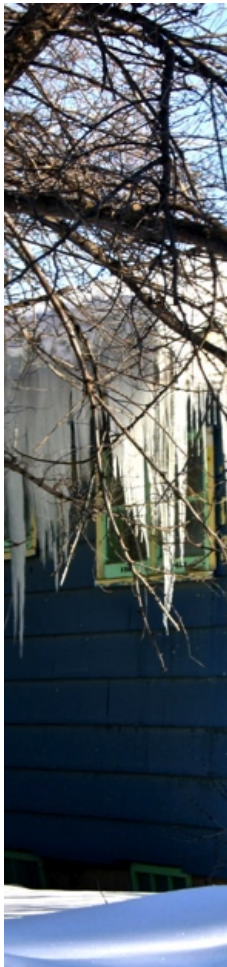
**Sodium in Canadian restaurant foods 'alarmingly high'**

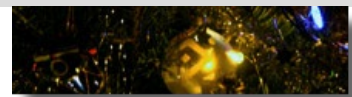
